I, Marthinus Johannes van Schalkwyk, Minister of Environmental Affairs and Tourism, hereby, under section 42 of the National Environmental Management Act, 1998 (Act No. 107 of 1998) read with section 6(1) of the National Environmental Management: Biodiversity Act, 2004 (Act No. 10 of 2004), delegate the authority to issue permits relating to the carrying out of restricted activities involving any listed threatened or protected species under regulation 3(2) of the Threatened or Protected Species Regulations, 2007, as amended, to the Director-General or any functionary acting in that position. The power includes the power to subdelegate.

I, Monde Mayekiso, Acting Director General of the Department of Environmental Affairs and Tourism, hereby subdelegate the delegated authority to issue permits relating to the carrying out of restricted activities involving any listed threatened or protected species under regulation 3(2) of the Threatened or Protected Species Regulations, 2007, as amended, and signed on 25 April 2008, to the Director. Regulation and Monitoring Services for aquatic, terrestrial species and marine species, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) The incumbents of higher posts in the relevant hierarchy may also exercise or perform such powers and duties; and
