APPLICANT: Fourie Family Association (H4/3/1/4057) 1.

ARMS: Azure, a cross fleuretty Or, charged with a fillet cross Gules, between in chief dexter an inverted chevron, sinister two bars gemelles wavy, and in base two cartouches all Argent; a chief of the last.

MOTTO: FOURIÉ CREDE DEO

APPLICANT: Legal Deposit Committee (H4/3/1/4081) 2.

BADGE: A triangle, per pale Argent and Vert, surmounted by an open book consisting of a cover and three pages, thereupon an oval sun placed fesswise, charged with a pierced roundel, all counterchanged.

3. APPLICANT: The South African Chefs' Association (H4/3/1/4089)

BADGE: A Saucepan spoon and whisk in saltire Or, their handles Vert, surmounted by a chef's hat of the first, charged in base with a barrulet Argent, surmounted and embellished of a pike erect embowed to sinister Vert, issuant from the hat flames of fire Or, and in base, between the handles of the spoon and whisk, a protea flower Or, seeded Argent, leafed Vert.

MOTTO: MASAKHANE, TEAM SA

4. APPLICANT: Ndlambe Municipality (H4/3/2/810)

ARMS: Per saltire Or, in base Argent and in the flanks per fess Vert and Brunâtre, in chief an aloe proper, in base an open book argent edged Azure, inscribed Sable, a base wavy Azure and Argent, and in the flanks over the partition lines, dexter an ox face caboshed proper and sinister a lion's footprint Brunâtre. The shield is ensigned of a beaded headring of Gules and Argent beads, heightened of waves of the sea Azure, issuant therefrom two

dolphins erect respectant, proper. Behind the shield is placed a spear and a knobkierie in saltire proper.

MOTTO: SISEBENZELA IKAMVA ELIHLE

5. APPLICANT: Thembelihle Municipality (H4/3/2/827)

ARMS: Or, a bend, wavy sinister Azure, and an anchor counterchanged, in chief a facetted diamond Argent, its lower point surmounting the anchor ring, and in base an aloe proper. The shield is ensigned of an open book Argent, bound Sable, surmounted by a human hand erect, clasping a demi cogwheel inverted Vert, flanked by two quill-pens Argent, shafts and nibs Sable.

MOTTO: TOGETHER WE CAN

6. APPLICANT: Mario Stefano Marco Texeira de Albergaria (H4/3/4/680)

BADGE: A plume of five ostrich feathers Argent, shanked Or, enfiled in base by a motto scroll Or, bearing the letters NE OBLIVISCARUS in letters Sable.

7. APPLICANT: Ernest Edward Aitchison (H4/3/4/886)

BADGE: A Maltese cross in saltire Vert, edged and balled Or, placed between the arms rock ivy leaves proper, charged in pale with a truncheon Argent, garnished Or, surmounted by an antique oil lamp Or, enflamed proper.

8. APPLICANT: William Sylvester Harle (H4/3/4/887)

ARMS: Argent, on a bend cottised Sable, three crosses paty Or; on a bordure Vert, nine fleurs-de-lis Or.

CREST: A gryphon's head erased Or.

WREATH AND MANTLING: Vert and Or.

MOTTO: Above the crest: PER DEUS SPEC

Below the shield: VACUUS DEUS - VACUUS PANTON

9. APPLICANT: Michele Fiaschi (H4/3/4/888)

ARMS: Gules, three Fiaschi (Italian flasks) Argent, placed one and two.

MOTTO: FORTITER IN RE, SUAVITER IN MODO

10. APPLICANT: Richard Bruce Lamb (H4/3/4/890)

ARMS: Vert, on a chevron Or, dexter two droplets Azure, sinister two boar heads couped close Sable, between in chief a hand balance the centre point embellished with a fleur-delis, Or, and in base an Angus Dei proper; over all at fess point a sword erect, blade Argent, quillioned, hilted and pommelled Or.

CREST: A Springbok head and neck, flanked on the dexter side by a Jacaranda wreath and on the sinister side by a protea wreath, all proper.

WREATH AND MANTLING: Vert and Or.

MOTTO: GOD ALONE
