SMALL CLAIMS COURTS ACT, 1984 (ACT NO. 61 OF 1984)

ESTABLISHMENT OF SMALL CLAIMS COURTS FOR THE AREAS OF ALIWAL NORTH AND LADY GREY AND WITHDRAWAL OF GOVERNMENT NOTICE NO. 601 OF 21 MAY 2004

- I, John Harold Jeffery, Deputy Minister of Justice and Constitutional Development, acting under the power delegated to me by the Minister of Justice and Correctional Services, under section 2 of the Small Claims Courts Act, 1984 (Act No. 61 of 1984), hereby -
 - (a) (i) establish a Small Claims Court for the adjudication of claims for the area of Aliwal North, consisting of the districts of Aliwal North and Jamestown:
 - (ii) determine Aliwal North to be the seat of the said Court; and
 - (iii) determine Aliwal North and Jamestown to be the places in that area for the holding of sessions of the said Court.
 - (b) (i) establish a Small Claims Court for the adjudication of claims for the area of Lady Grey, consisting of the district of Lady Grey;
 - (ii) determine Lady Grey to be the seat of the said Court; and
 - (iii) determine Lady Grey to be the place in that area for the holding of sessions of the said Court, and
 - (c) withdraw Government Notice No. 601 of 21 May 2004.

Despite the withdrawal of Government Notice No. 601 of 21 May 2004, any claim emanating from the district of Lady Grey which has already been instituted in the Small Claims Court of Aliwal North prior to the publication of this Government Notice, shall be continued and concluded in the Small Claims Court of Aliwal North as if this Government Notice has not been published.
