BETHELSDORP SETTLEMENT AMENDMENT ACT, 1979.

# ACT

To provide that the provisions of Part II of the Schedule to the Bethelsdorp Settlement Act, 1921, shall cease to apply with reference to certain land.

*(Afrikaans text signed by the State President.)  
(Assented to 6 March 1979.)*

**BE IT ENACTED** by the State President, the Senate and the House of Assembly of the Republic of South Africa, as follows:—

Part II of  
Schedule to  
Act 34 of 1921,  
not to apply  
in respect of  
certain land.

Short title.

1. As from the date of commencement of this Act the provisions of Part II of the Schedule to the Bethelsdorp Settlement Act, 1921, shall cease to apply with reference to the land granted to the Divisional Council of Port Elizabeth by Crown Grant No. 148/1949 dated 15 August 1949.

2. This Act shall be called the Bethelsdorp Settlement 10 Amendment Act, 1979.
