ACT

To amend the Mental Health Act, 1973, so as to authorize the Minister to make contributions in respect of the maintenance of, and expenditure incurred in connection with the care and treatment of, certain patients.

BE IT ENACTED by the State President and the Parliament of the Republic of South Africa, as follows:—

(2) The circumstances under which and the conditions on which contributions mentioned in subsection (1) may be made, the amounts of such contributions and the manner of accounting for contributions received shall be prescribed by the Minister with the 15 concurrence of the Minister of Finance.".

2. This Act shall be called the Mental Health Amendment Act, 1985.
