RE IT ENACTED by the State President, the Senate and the House of Assembly of the Republic of South Africa, as follows:-

1. (1) When in the case of a reorganization or readjustment of Administration of 5 the functions of departments of State, the administration of the provisions of any law which are assigned to any Minister of State are assigned to another Minister of State, or the administration of such provisions otherwise necessitates it, the State President may direct that powers duties are functions which is the state of that have a first that the state of the law and the state of the state direct that powers, duties or functions which in terms of that law 10 are or may be conferred or imposed upon or assigned to an officer in the public service
