ANIMALS PROTECTION AMENDMENT ACT, 1985

GENERAL EXPLANATORY NOTE:

Words in bold type in square brackets indicate omissions from existing enactments.

Words underlined with solid line indicate insertions in existing enactments.

ACT

To amend the Performing Animals Protection Act, 1935, so as to emend the Afrikaans text of section 3 (2) and to increase certain penalties; to amend the Animals Protection Act, 1962, so as to increase certain fines; to increase the maximum amount of compensation which can be granted to a person in respect of loss suffered or expense incurred by him as a result of an offence committed in terms of the last-mentioned Act; to substitute a reference to a repealed Act and to delete a similar reference; and to make other provision in respect of the disposal of any animal or thing seized in the course of the prevention of cruelty to animals; and to provide for matters connected therewith.

(English text signed by the State President.) (Assented to 15 March 1985.)

BE IT ENACTED by the State President and the Parliament of the Republic of South Africa, as follows:—

Amendment of section 3 of Act 24 of 1935.

Substitution of section 5 of Act 24 of 1935, as substituted by section 2 of Act 7 of 1972.

1. Section 3 of the Performing Animals Protection Act, 1935, is hereby amended by the substitution in the Afrikaans text of subsection (2) for the word "lisensie" of the word "sertifikaat".

2. The following section is hereby substituted for section 5 of the Performing Animals Protection Act, 1935:

"Obstruction of police officer.

5. Any person who wilfully obstructs, delays or otherwise interferes with a police officer in the exercise of the powers herein granted, or who conceals 10 any animal with intent to defeat the exercise of such powers, or otherwise hampers or impedes the exercise of such powers shall be guilty of an offence and liable on conviction to a fine not exceeding [one hundred rand] R2 000 or to imprisonment for a period 15 not exceeding [three] twelve months in addition to any other penalty imposed for the contravention of any provision of this Act or any regulation made thereunder."

Amendment of section 7 of Act 24 of 1935, as amended by section 4 of Act 7 of 1972 and section 1 of Act 54 of 1983.

3. Section 7 of the Performing Animals Protection Act, 1935, 20 is hereby amended by the substitution for paragraph (e) of the following paragraph:

"(e) a penalty of a fine not exceeding [one thousand rand] R2 000 or imprisonment for a period not exceeding twelve months for a contravention of any regulation,".

Amendment of section 8 of Act 24 of 1935, as amended by section 5 of Act 7 of 1972 and section 2 of Act 54 of 1983. 4. Section 8 of the Performing Animals Protection Act, 1935, is hereby amended by the substitution for subsection (1) of the following subsection:

"(1) Any person contravening the provisions of this Act or any regulation made thereunder for which a penalty has 5 not been prescribed or any condition of a licence or certificate shall be guilty of an offence and liable on conviction

to a fine not exceeding **[one thousand rand]** R2 000 or to imprisonment for a period not exceeding twelve months.".

Amendment of section 2 of Act 71 of 1962, as amended by section 21 of Act 102 of 1972 and section 3 of Act 54 of 1983.

5. Section 2 of the Animals Protection Act, 1962 (hereinafter 10 referred to as the principal Act), is hereby amended by the substitution in subsection (1) for the words following upon paragraph (s) of the following words:

"shall, subject to the provisions of this Act and any other law, be guilty of an offence and liable on conviction to a 15 fine not exceeding [one thousand rand] R2 000 or in default of payment to imprisonment for a period not exceeding twelve months or to such imprisonment without the option of a fine, or, where any such act or omission is of a wilful and an aggravated nature, to a whipping not exceeding six 20 strokes or to both such a fine and such a whipping or to both such imprisonment without the option of a fine and such a whipping."

Amendment of section 4 of Act 71 of 1962, as amended by section 9 of Act 7 of 1972.

6. Section 4 of the principal Act is hereby amended—

(a) by the substitution for subsection (1) of the following 25 subsection:

"(1) Whenever any person is convicted by a magistrate's court of an offence under this Act and it is proved that such person has by the commission of that offence caused loss to any other person or that any 30 other person has as the result of such offence incurred expense in providing necessary veterinary attention or treatment, food or accommodation for any animal in respect of which the offence was committed or in caring for such animal pending the making of an order by the 35 court for the disposal thereof, the court may, on application by such other person or by the person conducting the prosecution acting on the instructions of such other person, summarily enquire into and determine the amount of the loss so caused or expense so incurred 40 and give judgment against the person convicted and in favour of such other person for the amount so determined, but not exceeding an amount of **[four hundred rand]** R5 000."; and

(b) by the substitution for paragraph (a) of subsection (3) 45

of the following paragraph:

"(a) any costs incurred in connection with the custody of an animal seized in terms of the Criminal Procedure Act, [1955 (Act No. 56 of 1955)] 1977 (Act No. 51 of 1977), [or the Criminal Procedure Ordi- 50 nance, 1963 (Ordinance No. 34 of 1963), of the territory of South-West Africa,] for the purposes of a prosecution in terms of this Act; and".

Amendment of section 8 of Act 71 of 1962.

7. Section 8 of the principal Act is hereby amended by the substitution for paragraph (c) of subsection (1) of the following 55 paragraph:

(c) on the arrest of any person on a charge of an offence under this Act, seize any animal or thing in the possession or custody of that person at the time of the arrest and take it forthwith [before] to a [magistrate] police 60 officer, who shall deal with it in accordance with the provisions of the Criminal Procedure Act, 1977 (Act No. 51 of 1977);".

Amendment of section 10 of Act 71 of 1962, as amended by section 4 of Act 54 of 1983.

8. Section 10 of the principal Act is hereby amended by the substitution for subsection (2) of the following subsection:

"(2) Such regulations may prescribe penalties for contravention thereof or failure to comply therewith not exceeding a fine of [one thousand rand] R2 000 or im- 5 prisonment for a period of twelve months."

Short title.

9. This Act shall be called the Animals Protection Amendment Act, 1985.
