UNEMPLOYMENT INSURANCE SECOND AMENDMENT ACT, 1986 Act No. 30, 1986

ACT

To amend the Unemployment Insurance Act, 1966, so as to empower the Director-General: Manpower in certain circumstances to raise loans for the unemployment insurance fund from private institutions; and to abolish the arrangement for the payment by the said fund of the training expenses of a contributor; and to provide for matters connected therewith.
