ACT

To amend the Business Names Act, 1960, relating to the former christian name and surname of any person carrying on business; and to authorize the Registrar to assign his powers and duties; and to provide for incidental matters.

(Afrikaans text signed by the State President.)
(Assented to 29 March 1979.)

BE IT ENACTED by the State President, the Senate and the House of Assembly of the Republic of South Africa, as follows:—

Amendment of section 3 of Act 27 of 1960.

1. Section 3 of the Business Names Act, 1960 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act), is hereby amended by the substitution for the expression "twenty", where it occurs in paragraph (b) of subsection (2), of the expression "ten".

Insertion of section 5A in Act 27 of 1960. 2. The following section is hereby inserted in the principal Act after section 5:

"Assigning of powers and duties by Registrar. 5A. The Registrar may in writing assign any power 10 conferred upon or duty entrusted to him by this Act to an officer in the public service who in his opinion is competent therefor.".

Short title.

3. This Act shall be called the Business Names Amendment Act, 1979.
