To empower provincial councils to make ordinances relating to pensions and gratuities for members and the widows and dependants of members of a provincial council or an executive committee; and to provide for matters connected therewith.

BE IT ENACTED by the State President, the Senate and the House of Assembly of the Republic of South Africa, as

1. (1) A provincial council shall have power to make Provincial councils 5 ordinances relating to pensions and gratuities for members and the may make ordinances widows and dependants of members of any provincial council or relating to pensions executive committee.

(2) Subject to the provisions of subsection (3), any pension or for members and gratuity referred to in subsection (1) shall not exceed an amount dependants of which, if calculated over a period of 12 months, is equal to the members of provinhighest amount that was payable in respect of any year during the cial period of office of the member concerned, to that member under councils or sections 74 and 76 of the Republic of South Africa Constitution executive committees. (3) The Administrator of a province, with the concurrence of the Minister of Finance, may from time to time authorize the increase of any pension referred to in subsection (1) or the payment of an allowance additional to that pension, in accordance with such rates or scales, in such circumstances, on such

20 conditions and with effect from such date, which may be a date in the past, as the Administrator, with the concurrence of the Minister of Finance, may determine.

2. The Provincial Powers Extension Act, 1960 (Act No. 42 of Repeal of laws. 1960), and the Provincial Powers Extension Amendment Act, 25 1975 (Act No. 20 of 1975), are hereby repealed.

3. This Act shall be called the Provincial Powers Extension Short title and commence-April 1975 April 1975.
