PROVINCIAL POWERS EXTENSION ACT, 1980

Act No. 32, 1980

ACT

To empower provincial councils to make ordinances relating to pensions and gratuities for members and the widows and dependants of members of a provincial council or an executive committee; and to provide for matters connected therewith.

*(Afrikaans text signed by the State President.)
(Assented to 31 March 1980.)*

BE IT ENACTED by the State President, the Senate and the House of Assembly of the Republic of South Africa, as follows:—

1. (1) A provincial council shall have power to make Provincial councils may make ordinances relating to pensions and gratuities for members and the widows and dependants of members of any provincial council or executive committee.
- (2) Subject to the provisions of subsection (3), any pension or gratuity referred to in subsection (1) shall not exceed an amount which, if calculated over a period of 12 months, is equal to the highest amount that was payable in respect of any year during the period of office of the member concerned, to that member under sections 74 and 76 of the Republic of South Africa Constitution Act, 1961 (Act No. 32 of 1961).
- (3) The Administrator of a province, with the concurrence of the Minister of Finance, may from time to time authorize the increase of any pension referred to in subsection (1) or the payment of an allowance additional to that pension, in accordance with such rates or scales, in such circumstances, on such conditions and with effect from such date, which may be a date in the past, as the Administrator, with the concurrence of the Minister of Finance, may determine.
2. The Provincial Powers Extension Act, 1960 (Act No. 42 of 1960), and the Provincial Powers Extension Amendment Act, 1975 (Act No. 20 of 1975), are hereby repealed.
3. This Act shall be called the Provincial Powers Extension Act, 1980, and shall be deemed to have come into operation on 2 April 1975.

Provincial councils may make ordinances relating to pensions and gratuities for members and widows and dependants of members of provincial councils or executive committees.
