STOCK THEFT AMENDMENT ACT, 1986

To amend the Stock Theft Act, 1959, so as to increase the maximum amounts of fines which may be imposed under the Act.

RE IT ENACTED by the State President and the Parliament of the Republic of South Africa, as follows:-

1. Section 13 of the Stock Theft Act, 1959 (hereinafter refer- Amendment of red to as the principal Act), is hereby amended by the substitu-5 tion for subparagraph (v) of paragraph (a) of the following sub-as amended by paragraph:

as amended by section 6 of Act 59 of 1983.

"(v) a fine not exceeding [R2 000] R4 000; or".

2. The following section is hereby substituted for section 14 of Substitution of the principal Act:

section 14 of Act 57 of 1959

10 "Penalty where not otherwise provided for.

14. Any person who is convicted of an offence as substituted by under this Act for which no penalty is otherwise provided shall be liable to a fine not exceeding [R1 000] Act 59 of 1983. R2 000 or to imprisonment for a period not exceeding one year or to both such fine and such imprisonment.".

3. This Act shall be called the Stock Theft Amendment Act, Short title. 1986.
