BLACK ADMINISTRATION AMENDMENT ACT, 1981

GENERAL EXPLANATORY NOTE:

ACT

To amend the Black Administration Act, 1927, so as to exclude certain persons from the jurisdiction of a Commissioner's Court; and to provide for matters connected therewith.

(English text signed by the State President.) (Assented to 3 March 1981.)

B^E IT ENACTED by the State President and the House of Assembly of the Republic of South Africa, as follows:—

1. Section 10 of the Black Administration Act, 1927, is hereby amended by the addition to the proviso to subsection (1) of the following paragraph:

"(f) any person who is immune from the jurisdiction of the courts of the Republic in terms of section 2 or 2A of

the Diplomatic Privileges Act, 1951 (Act No. 71 of 1951), and who is not a South African citizen, is a party.".
