STATE ATTORNEY AMENDMENT ACT, 1980

Act No. 45, 1980

GENERAL EXPLANATORY NOTE:

Words underlined with solid line indicate insertions in existing enactments.

ACT

To amend the State Attorney Act, 1957, so as to make provision for the performance under certain circumstances of work by the State Attorney's office or a branch thereof for or on behalf of the government of a foreign state; and to provide for matters connected therewith.

(Assented to 28 April 1980.)*

BE IT ENACTED by the State President, the Senate and the House of Assembly of the Republic of South Africa, as follows:—

1. The following section is hereby inserted in the State Attorney Act, 1957, after section 9:

"Perform- ance by State Attorney's office of 10 work on behalf of government of foreign state.	<p>9A. If agreed upon between the Government of the Republic and the government of any other state, the State Attorney's office or any branch thereof may perform such kind of work as is performed under this Act by the said office or any such branch on behalf of the Government of the Republic, for or on behalf of the government of that other state in any court or in any part of the Republic or in that state, subject to such conditions as may be so agreed upon."</p>
