GOLD MINES ASSISTANCE ACT REPEAL ACT, 1987

\mathbf{ACT}

To repeal the Gold Mines Assistance Act, 1968.

(English text signed by the State President.) (Assented to 11 September 1987.)

BE IT ENACTED by the State President and the Parliament of the Republic of South Africa, as follows:—

Repeal of Act 82 of 1968, section 15 of Act 91 of 1971, Act 29 of 1975, Act 81 of 1976 and section 8 of Act 113 of 1984.

1. The Gold Mines Assistance Act, 1968, section 15 of the Finance Act, 1971, the Gold Mines Assistance Amendment Act, 1975, the Gold Mines Assistance Amendment Act, 1976, and 5 section 8 of the Finance Act, 1984, are hereby repealed.

Short title and commencement.

2. This Act shall be called the Gold Mines Assistance Act Repeal Act, 1987, and shall come into operation on a date fixed by the State President by proclamation in the *Gazette*.
