### **GENERAL EXPLANATORY NOTE:**

To amend the National Welfare Act, 1965, so as to repeal the provisions relating to the circumstances under which persons may not be registered as social workers; and to create an additional offence.

(English text signed by the State President.) (Assented to 29 May 1978.)

BE IT ENACTED by the State President, the Senate and the House of Assembly of the Republic of South Africa, as follows:-

1. Section 34 of the National Welfare Act, 1965, is hereby Repeal of 5 repealed.

section 34 of Act 79 of 1965.

2. Section 37 of the National Welfare Act, 1965, is hereby Amendment of amended by the substitution for paragraph (a) of subsection (1) of Section 37 of Act 79 of 1965.

the following paragraph:

"(a) use the title 'registered social worker' or directly or indirectly hold himself out as a registered social worker 10 or take part at any institution in the training of any person in any aspect of social work unless he is registered under section 33, whether conditionally or otherwise, as a social worker or, in the case of a person 15 so taking part in such training, was appointed at such institution within a period of five years after 1 July 1966; or".

3. This Act shall be called the National Welfare Amendment Short title. Act, 1978.
