# ACT

To amend the Expropriation Act, 1975, relating to the tariffs of court and other fees in connection with the proceedings before compensation courts.

*(Afrikaans text signed by the State President.)  
(Assented to 18 March 1980.)*

**BE IT ENACTED** by the State President, the Senate and the House of Assembly of the Republic of South Africa, as follows:—

1. Section 25 of the Expropriation Act, 1975, is hereby amended by the substitution for paragraph (c) of subsection (1) of the following paragraph: Amendment of section 25 of Act 63 of 1975, as amended by section 3 of Act 3 of 1978.
- “(c) the tariff of court and other fees (excluding advocates’ and attorneys’ fees) and orders as to costs in connection with proceedings before a compensation court;”

- 10 2. This Act shall be called the Expropriation Amendment Act, 1980. Short title.
