(English text signed by the State President.) (Assented to 12 June 1980.)

BE IT ENACTED by the State President, the Senate and the House of Assembly of the Republic of South Africa, as follows:—

1. The following section is hereby inserted in the Police Act, Insertion of section 27C in Act 7 of 1958.
