ADMINISTRATION OF ESTATES AMENDMENT ACT, 1981

GENERAL EXPLANATORY NOTE:

ACT

To amend the Administration of Estates Act, 1965, so as to increase a certain amount.

(English text signed by the State President.) (Assented to 6 October 1981.)

BE IT ENACTED by the State President and the House of Assembly of the Republic of South Africa, as follows:—

Amendment of section 18 of Act 66 of 1965, as amended by section 1 of Act 15 of 1978.

Short title.

1. Section 18 of the Administration of Estates Act, 1965, is hereby amended by the substitution for subsection (3) of the following subsection:

"(3) If the value of any estate does not exceed **[one** thousand five hundred] fifteen thousand rand, the Master may dispense with a notice under subsection (1) and with the appointment of an executor and give directions as to the manner in which any such estate shall be liquidated and 10 distributed.".

2. This Act shall be called the Administration of Estates Amendment Act, 1981.
