LANDBANK AMENDMENT ACT, 1976

Act No. 109, 1976

ACT

To amend the Land Bank Act, 1944, in order to provide for the making of advances to the South African Bantu Trust and for matters connected therewith.

*(English text signed by the State President.)
(Assented to 5 July 1976.)*

BE IT ENACTED by the State President, the Senate and the House of Assembly of the Republic of South Africa, as follows:—

1. Section 21 of the Land Bank Act, 1944, is hereby amended by the insertion after paragraph (c) of subsection (1) of the following paragraph:

“(c)*bis* to advance money to the South African Bantu Trust, established by the Bantu Trust and Land Act, 1936 (Act No. 18 of 1936);”.

Amendment of section 21 of Act 13 of 1944, as amended by section 6 of Act 47 of 1959, section 2 of Act 35 of 1961, section 1 of Act 14 of 1964, section 5 of Act 46 of 1965, section 13 of Act 5 of 1968, section 3 of Act 41 of 1972 and section 1 of Act 52 of 1975.
2. The following heading and section are hereby inserted in the Land Bank Act, 1944, after section 45*bis*:

“ADVANCES TO THE SOUTH AFRICAN BANTU TRUST

Advances to the South African Bantu Trust. **45*ter***. (1) The bank may, on such conditions as the board may determine, advance money to the South African Bantu Trust, established by the Bantu Trust and Land Act, 1936 (Act No. 18 of 1936), to repay any money owing to the bank by a person whose land has been acquired by the said Trust.

(2) The repayment of any money advanced in terms of subsection (1), and the payment of interest thereon, shall be deemed to be guaranteed by the Government.”.

Insertion of new heading and section 45*ter* in Act 13 of 1944.
3. This Act shall be called the Land Bank Amendment Act, 1976. Short title.
