It is hereby notified that the State President has assented to the following Act which is hereby published for general information:—

FERTILIZERS, FARM FEEDS, AGRICULTURAL REMEDIES AND Act No. 17, 1972
STOCK REMEDIES AMENDMENT ACT, 1972.

ACT

To amend the Fertilizers, Farm Feeds, Agricultural Remedies and Stock Remedies Act, 1947, so as to apply that Act to the territory of South-West Africa; and to provide for incidental matters.

(English text signed by the Acting State President.)
(Assented to 23rd March, 1972.)

BE IT ENACTED by the State President, the Senate and the House of Assembly of the Republic of South Africa, as follows:—

1. Section 1 of the Fertilizers, Farm Feeds, Agricultural Remedies and Stock Remedies Act, 1947 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act), is hereby amended by the insertion after the definition of "prescribed" of the following definition:

"‘Republic’ includes the territory of South-West Africa;".

Amendment of section 1 of Act 36 of 1947, as amended by section 32 of Act 28 of 1961 and section 1 of Act 60 of 1970.
2. Section 16 of the principal Act is hereby amended by the substitution for subsection (1) of the following subsection:

“(1) Any officer of the Department of Customs and Excise authorized thereto by the Secretary for Customs and Excise may detain any quantity of farming requisites landed at or imported through any port or place in the Republic, and may take samples thereof.”.

Amendment of section 16 of Act 36 of 1947 as amended by section 37 of Act 28 of 1961.
3. The following section is hereby inserted in the principal Act after section 23:

24. This Act and any amendment thereof shall apply also to the territory of South-West Africa, including the Eastern Caprivi Zipfel.”.

Insertion of section 24 in Act 36 of 1947.
4. The Fertilisers, Farm Foods, Seeds and Pest Remedies Ordinance, 1930 (Ordinance No. 15 of 1930), of the territory of South-West Africa is hereby repealed.

Repeal of Ordinance 15 of 1930 of South-West Africa.
5. This Act shall be called the Fertilizers, Farm Feeds, Agricultural Remedies and Stock Remedies Amendment Act, 1972, and shall come into operation on a date to be fixed by the State President by proclamation in the *Gazette*.
