NATIONAL MONUMENTS AMENDMENT ACT, 1971.

# ACT

To amend the provisions of the National Monuments Act, 1969, relating to the declaration of immovable property to be national monuments.

*(English text signed by the State President.)*  
*(Assented to 30th April, 1971.)*

**BE IT ENACTED** by the State President, the Senate and the House of Assembly of the Republic of South Africa, as follows:—

Amendment of section 10 of Act 28 of 1969.

1. Section 10 of the National Monuments Act, 1969, is hereby amended by the substitution for paragraph (c) of subsection (3) of the following paragraph:

“(c) that, in the case of movable property, such property has been in the Republic for more than fifty years.”.

Short title.

2. This Act shall be called the National Monuments Amendment Act, 1971.
