PARLIAMENTARY SERVICE ACT, 1974.

Act No. 33, 1974

To give effect to a resolution of the Senate and of the House of Assembly to establish a staff of Parliament; for that purpose to amend the Electoral Consolidation Act, 1946, the Republic of South Africa Constitution Act, 1961, the Payment of Members of Parliament Act, 1961, the Justices of the Peace and Commissioners of Oaths Act, 1963, the Powers and Privileges of Parliament Act, 1963, the Customs and Excise Act, 1964, and the Parliamentary Service and Administrators' Pensions Act, 1971; and to provide for incidental matters.

RE IT ENACTED by the State President, the Senate and the House of Assembly of the Republic of South Africa,

1.
