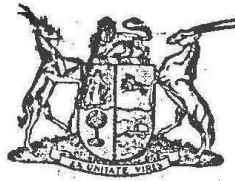

## SUPREME COURT AMENDMENT ACT, 1976.

Act No. 37, 1976

**ACT**

To amend the Supreme Court Act, 1959, so as to provide for the custody and disposal of records and minutes of evidence and of the proceedings in courts of the provincial and local divisions of the Supreme Court of South Africa.

*(English text signed by the State President.)  
(Assented to 19 March 1976.)*

**BE IT ENACTED** by the State President, the Senate and the House of Assembly of the Republic of South Africa, as follows:—

1. Section 43 of the Supreme Court Act, 1959, is hereby amended by the substitution for paragraph (o) of subsection (3) of the following paragraph:  
“*(o)* the manner of recording or noting of evidence and of the proceedings in any court, and the custody and disposal of records or minutes of such evidence and proceedings;”  
Amendment of section 43 of Act 59 of 1959, as amended by section 39 of Act 93 of 1962, section 11 of Act 85 of 1963, section 42 of Act 80 of 1964 and section 10 of Act 15 of 1969.
2. This Act shall be called the Supreme Court Amendment Act, 1976. Short title.
