ACT

To amend the Cape Town Foreshore Act, 1950.

(English text signed by the Governor-General.)
(Assented to 21st April, 1960.)

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate and the House of Assembly of the Union of South Africa, as follows:—

1. Section *fifteen* of the Cape Town Foreshore Act, 1950, is hereby amended by the addition to sub-section (1) of the following proviso: Amendment of section 15 of Act 26 of 1950.

“Provided that if in the case of any such land or property let by the board, the Minister after consultation with the board and the council so determines, the council may levy rates, payable by the lessee concerned, on that land or property as from a date and on the basis similarly determined by the Minister.”.

2. This Act shall be called the Cape Town Foreshore Amendment Act, 1960. Short title.
