It is hereby notified that the State President has assented to the following Act which is hereby published for general information:—

ACT

To amend the National War Fund Act, 1970, in order to provide for certain amendments to certain title deeds, mortgage bonds, registers and documents; and to provide for incidental matters.

BE IT ENACTED by the State President, the Senate and the House of Assembly of the Republic of South Africa, as follows:—

(English text signed by the State President.)
(Assented to 16th May, 1972.)

1. The following section is hereby inserted in the National War Fund Act, 1970, after section 1:

“Duties of certain registrars of deeds in respect of certain title deeds and mortgage bonds.

1A. (1) If a title deed of any immovable property registered in the name of the National War Fund (1939–1945) or if a mortgage bond registered in favour of the National War Fund (1939–1945), is submitted to the registrar of deeds or registrar of Rand townships concerned, such registrar shall substitute on such title deed or mortgage bond and in all the appropriate registers and documents in his custody, for the name National War Fund (1939–1945) the name National War Fund.

(2) No office fees, stamp duty or transfer duty shall be payable in respect of any substitution referred to in subsection (1).”
