## SOUTH AFRICAN CITIZENSHIP AMENDMENT ACT, 1978.

#### **GENERAL EXPLANATORY NOTE:**

To amend the South African Citizenship Act, 1949, so as to provide for the acquisition of South African citizenship by virtue of permanent residence in the Republic and for matters connected therewith.

BE IT ENACTED by the State President, the Senate and the House of Assembly of the Republic of South Africa, as follows:-

has been made, be deemed to be an alien who, for the purposes of the Aliens Act, 1937, is not in possession of a permit issued to him in terms of section 4 or 5 of the said Act;

a permit may not in terms of section 4 of the said (b) Act be issued to him; and

he shall be disqualified from acquiring South African citizenship in any manner.

(4) If a declaration contemplated in subsection (1) has been made on behalf of a minor, he may at any time during a period of three months after attaining majority make a declaration in the prescribed form stating that he wishes to become a South African citizen, and thereupon the provisions of subsection (3) (b) and (c) shall cease to apply in respect of him.

(5) The Minister shall once in every three months cause to be published in the Gazette a return of all aliens by or on behalf of whom declarations were in terms of subsection (1) or (4) made during the preceding three months, and in that return cause to be set out in relation to every such person such particulars as he may from time to time deem fit.".
