## ACT

#### To apply the Legal Aid Act, 1969, to the territory of South-West Africa.

#### (English text signed by the State President.) (Assented to 4th June, 1971.)

**B**E IT ENACTED by the State President, the Senate and the House of Assembly of the Republic of South Africa, as follows:---

Insertion of section 9A in Act 22 of 1969.

1. The Legal Aid Act, 1969, is hereby amended by the insertion

after section 9 of the following section: "Applica-tion to apply also in the territory 9A. This Act and any amendment thereof shall apply also in the territory of South-West Africa, including the Eastern Caprivi Zipfel.". the territory of South-West Africa.

Short title.

2. This Act shall be called the Legal Aid Amendment Act, 1971.
