To amend the constitution of the Council of the South African \*\*\*\*Bureau of Standards; and to provide for matters incidental

RE IT ENACTED by the State President, the Senate and the House of Assembly of the Republic of South Africa, as

1. Section 1 of the Standards Act, 1962 (hereinafter referred Amendment of to as the principal Act), is hereby amended by the deletion of section of Act in the deficitions of "Akademie" and "associated societies" the definitions of "Akademie" and "associated societies".

2. The following section is hereby substituted for section 5 Substitution of of the principal Act:

33 of 1962.

- 5. (1) Subject to the provisions of subsection (2) stitution of council. the council shall consist of a chairman and seven other members who shall be appointed by the Minister and who shall all be persons with special knowledge or experience of matters relating to the objects for which the bureau has been established.
  - (2) Any person who immediately before the commencement of the Standards Amendment Act, 1968, was chairman or any other member of the council, shall be deemed to have been appointed as chairman or other member of the council under this section, as substituted by section 2 of the said Act: Provided that the period of office of any such person as chairman or other member of the council shall expire on the date on which his period of office would have expired if the Standards Amendment Act, 1968, had not come into operation.".
  - 3. Section 6 of the principal Act is hereby repealed.

4. Section 7 of the principal Act is hereby amended by the Amendment of substitution for paragraph (b) of subsection (2) of the following section 7 of Act paragraph:

"(b) in the case of any other member, by the appointment of another person for the unexpired portion of the period for which the member whose office has become vacant, had been appointed.".

5. Section 9 of the principal Act is hereby amended by the Amendment of substitution for subsection (1) of the following subsection: section 9 of Act
"(1) The quorum for a meeting of the council shall be 33 of 1962. four of the members thereof.".

6. This Act shall be called the Standards Amendment Act, Short title.
