It is hereby notified that the State President has assented to the following Acts which are hereby published for general information.

ACT

To amend the constitution of the Council of the South African Bureau of Standards; and to provide for matters incidental thereto.

(Afrikaans text signed by the State President.)
(Assented to 13th June, 1968.)

BE IT ENACTED by the State President, the Senate and the House of Assembly of the Republic of South Africa, as follows:—

1. Section 1 of the Standards Act, 1962 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act), is hereby amended by the deletion of the definitions of "Akademie" and "associated societies".

Amendment of section 1 of Act 33 of 1962.

2. The following section is hereby substituted for section 5 of the principal Act:

Substitution of section 5 of Act 33 of 1962.

5. (1) Subject to the provisions of subsection (2) the council shall consist of a chairman and seven other members who shall be appointed by the Minister and who shall all be persons with special knowledge or experience of matters relating to the objects for which the bureau has been established.

(2) Any person who immediately before the commencement of the Standards Amendment Act, 1968, was chairman or any other member of the council, shall be deemed to have been appointed as chairman or other member of the council under this section, as substituted by section 2 of the said Act: Provided that the period of office of any such person as chairman or other member of the council shall expire on the date on which his period of office would have expired if the Standards Amendment Act, 1968, had not come into operation."

3. Section 6 of the principal Act is hereby repealed.

Repeal of section 6 of Act 33 of 1962.

4. Section 7 of the principal Act is hereby amended by the substitution for paragraph (b) of subsection (2) of the following paragraph:

Amendment of section 7 of Act 33 of 1962.

"(b) in the case of any other member, by the appointment of another person for the unexpired portion of the period for which the member whose office has become vacant, had been appointed."

5. Section 9 of the principal Act is hereby amended by the substitution for subsection (1) of the following subsection:

Amendment of section 9 of Act 33 of 1962.

"(1) The quorum for a meeting of the council shall be four of the members thereof."

6. This Act shall be called the Standards Amendment Act, Short title 1968.
