INDECENT OR OBSCENE PHOTOGRAPHIC MATTER  
AMENDMENT ACT, 1983

GENERAL EXPLANATORY NOTE:

Words underlined with solid line indicate insertions in existing enactments.

**ACT**

To amend the Indecent or Obscene Photographic Matter Act, 1967, so as to extend the meaning of the words "cinematograph film".

*(English text signed by the State President.)  
(Assented to 3 June 1983.)*

**BE IT ENACTED** by the State President and the House of Assembly of the Republic of South Africa, as follows:—

Amendment of section 1 of Act 37 of 1967, as amended by section 50 of Act 42 of 1974.

1. Section 1 of the Indecent or Obscene Photographic Matter Act, 1967, is hereby amended by the insertion before the definition of "committee" of the following definition: 5  
"cinematograph film' includes any magnetic tape or other object consisting of material of whatever nature, on which any image or images have been recorded in such a manner that such image or images will be capable of being exhibited as a moving picture or otherwise 10 through any mechanical, electronic or other device;"

Short title.

2. This Act shall be called the Indecent or Obscene Photographic Matter Amendment Act, 1983.
