It is hereby notified that the State President has assented to the following Act which is hereby published for general information:—

ACT

To amend the Explosives Act, 1956, by the substitution for the expression "one thousand pounds in weight" in section 6 of the expression "500 kilograms", and for the expression "one mile" in section 13 of the expression "2 kilometres"; to apply the said Act to the territory of South-West Africa; to repeal the Explosives Ordinance, 1962, and Government Notice No. 52 of 1968, of the territory of South-West Africa; and to provide for incidental matters.

BE IT ENACTED by the State President, the Senate and the House of Assembly of the Republic of South Africa, as follows:—

1. Section 6 of the Explosives Act, 1956 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act), is hereby amended by the substitution for the expression "one thousand pounds in weight", where it occurs in paragraph (d) of subsection (1), of the expression "500 kilograms". Amendment of section 6 of Act 26 of 1956, as amended by section 3 of Act 21 of 1963.
2. Section 13 of the principal Act is hereby amended by the substitution for the expression "one mile", where it occurs in subsection (3), of the expression "2 kilometres". Amendment of section 13 of Act 26 of 1956.
3. The following section is hereby inserted in the principal Act after section 31: Insertion of section 31A in Act 26 of 1956.
 "Applica- **31A.** This Act and any amendment thereof shall

4. The Explosives Ordinance, 1962 (Ordinance No. 31 of 1962), and Government Notice No. 52 of 1968, of the territory of South-West Africa, are hereby repealed. Repeal of laws.
5. This Act shall be called the Explosives Amendment Act, Short title. 1972.
