ACT

To amend the provisions of the Business Names Act, 1960, relating to the definition of "business", and to provide for incidental matters.

(Afrikaans text signed by the State President.)
(Assented to 14th June, 1972.)

BE IT ENACTED by the State President, the Senate and the House of Assembly of the Republic of South Africa, as follows:—

1. Section 1 of the Business Names Act, 1960, is hereby amended by the substitution for the definition of "business" of the following definition: Amendment of section 1 of Act 27 of 1960.

“‘business’ means any business of trade established for the acquisition of gain and carried on by any person, company, association, syndicate or partnership, or by the individual members of any company, association, syndicate or partnership;”.

2. This Act shall be called the Business Names Amendment Act, 1972.
