PUBLIC SERVICE AND POST OFFICE SERVICE AMENDMENT Act No. 97, 1976
ACT, 1976.**ACT**

To amend the Public Service Act, 1957, and the Post Office Service Act, 1974, so as to further regulate the requirements in regard to citizenship that apply in the case of permanent appointments in the public service and the service of the Department of Posts and Telecommunications, respectively.

BE IT ENACTED by the State President, the Senate and the House of Assembly of the Republic of South Africa, as follows:—

1. Section 11 of the Public Service Act, 1957, is hereby amended by the substitution for paragraph (a) of subsection (2) of the following paragraph:

“(a) is a South African citizen, or is a citizen of any territory which formed part of the Republic and in terms of an Act of Parliament became an independent State;”.

Amendment of section 11 of Act 54 of 1957, as amended by section 2 of Act 9 of 1961, section 4 of Act 86 of 1969 and section 1 of Act 54 of 1973.
2. Section 11 of the Post Office Service Act, 1974, is hereby amended by the substitution for paragraph (a) of the following paragraph:

“(a) is a South African citizen, or is a citizen of any territory which formed part of the Republic and in terms of an Act of Parliament became an independent State;”.

Amendment of section 11 of Act 66 of 1974.
3. This Act shall be called the Public Service and Post Office Service Amendment Act, 1976.
