ACT

To provide for the application to the United Municipal Executive of South Africa of the provisions of the Local Government Superannuation Ordinance, 1930 (Transvaal).

(English text signed by the Governor-General.)
(Assented to 14th February, 1958.)

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate and the House of Assembly of the Union of South Africa, as follows:—

1. (1) Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in any other law contained, the provisions of the Local Government Superannuation Ordinance, 1930 (Transvaal), shall, subject to the provisions of sections *two* and *three*, apply *mutatis mutandis* in respect of the United Municipal Executive of South Africa and any person in its employ as if the said Executive were a local authority which has adopted the said Ordinance and become associated with the joint fund therein mentioned, and such person an employee in its service.

Ordinance No. 16 of 1930 (Transvaal) to apply in respect of United Municipal Executive of South Africa.

(2) Sub-section (1) shall be deemed to have come into operation on the first day of May, 1957.

2. Any such person's membership of the joint fund shall be subject to such terms and conditions, including terms and conditions as to the contributions payable to the said fund, as the Administrator of the Transvaal, acting on the advice and with the consent of the Executive Committee for that province, may determine.

Terms and conditions.

3. Any prior service of such person, within or outside the Transvaal, with any other employer may, subject to such conditions, including conditions as to the payment of any sum or sums to the said fund, as the Administrator acting as aforesaid may determine, be reckoned as service with the said Executive.

Prior service.

4. This Act shall be called the United Municipal Executive Short title. (Pensions) Act, 1958.
