To amend the Transfer Duty Act, 1949.

(Afrikaans text signed by the Governor-General.) (Assented to 15th June, 1954.)

B^E IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate and the House of Assembly of the Union of South Africa, as follows:-

1. (1) Section two of the Transfer Duty Act, 1949, is hereby Amendment of amended by the substitution for the proviso thereto of the Act 40 of following proviso: "Provided that on so much of the said value or the amended by said amount, as the case may be, as does not exceed five section 1 of thousand pounds, the duty shall be three pounds per Act 59 of 1951 and centum." centum.".

(2) The amendment effected by sub-section (1) shall apply Act 31 of in respect of any acquisition of property or any renunciation 1953. of an interest in or restriction upon the use or disposal of property on or after the twenty-fifth day of March, 1954.
