ACT

To amend the Cape Town Foreshore Act, 1950.

(English text signed by the State President.)
(Assented to 1st April, 1965.)

BE IT ENACTED by the State President, the Senate and the House of Assembly of the Republic of South Africa, as follows:—

Insertion of section 19bis in Act 26 of 1950.

1. (1) The following section is hereby inserted in the Cape Town Foreshore Act, 1950, after section *nineteen*:

“Delegation of the Minister’s powers. 19bis. The Minister may delegate any of the powers conferred on him by section *ten* of this Act to any officer referred to in sub-section (1) of section *eight* seconded to the service of the board.”.

(2) Sub-section (1) shall be deemed to have come into operation on the first day of August, 1950.

Short title.

2. This Act shall be called the Cape Town Foreshore Amendment Act, 1965.
