ACT

To amend the Merchandise Marks Act, 1941.

(English text signed by the Governor-General.) (Assented to 18th June, 1954.)

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate and the House of Assembly of the Union of South Africa, as follows:-

1. (1) Section one of the Merchandise Marks Act, 1941 Amendment of (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act), is hereby amended section 1 of Act by the addition at the end of the definition of "sell" of the amended by secwords ", and the word 'sale' has a corresponding meaning;". tion 1 of Act 39 (2) Sub-section (1) shall be deemed to have come into operation on the eighteenth day of October, 1941.

2. Section four of the principal Act is hereby amended by the Amendment of addition thereto of the following sub-section:

17 of 1941.

"(4) No compensation shall be payable in respect of any damage caused to any goods by any person in the exercise of his powers under this section, unless it is proved that such damage could have been avoided by the exercise. of reasonable care.".
