#### JUSTICES OF THE PEACE AND COMMISSIONERS OF OATHS AMENDMENT ACT, 1970.

Act No. 55, 1907

To amend the Justices of the Peace and Commissioners of Oaths Act, 1963, so as to apply that Act to the territory of South-West Africa; and to provide for incidental matters.

RE IT ENACTED by the State President, the Senate and the House of Assembly of the Republic of South Africa, as follows:-

(2) Any appointment made under or declared to remain in existence by any law repealed by subsection (1), and anything done in connection with or by virtue of any such appointment, shall remain of full force and effect as if that law had not been

(3) Anything done under any provision of a law repealed by subsection (1), shall be deemed to have been done under the corresponding provision, if any, of the principal Act.

(4) This section shall also apply in the Eastern Caprivi Zipfel.
