It is hereby notified that the State President has assented to the following Act which is hereby published for general information:—

NATIONAL WAR FUND ACT, 1970.

Act No. 81, 1970

ACT

To provide for the amalgamation of the funds known as the Governor-General's Fund (Great War 1914-1918) and the National War Fund (1939-1945); and for incidental matters.

*(Afrikaans text signed by the State President.)
(Assented to 30th September, 1970.)*

BE IT ENACTED by the State President, the Senate and the House of Assembly of the Republic of South Africa, as follows:—

1. (1) The fund known as the Governor-General's Fund (Great War 1914-1918) and the fund known as the National War Fund (1939-1945) shall as from the date of commencement of this Act be deemed to have been amalgamated and to form one fund, which shall be called the National War Fund. Amalgamation of war funds.

(2) (a) The trust deed and the constitution of the said National War Fund (1939-1945) as they existed immediately before the said date, shall as from that date be deemed to be the trust deed and the constitution of the National War Fund, which shall be administered in accordance with the provisions thereof, subject, however, to the provisions of subsection (3).

(b) Paragraph (a) shall not be construed so as to prohibit the amendment of the said trust deed or of the said constitution in any manner in which it could have been amended before the said date.

(3) For the purposes of subsection (2)—

(a) any reference in the said trust deed and constitution, and in so far as it may be necessary or expedient in order to give effect to the provisions of this Act, in any related document, to the National War Fund (1939-1945), shall be construed as a reference to the National War Fund;

(b) any reference in the definition of "South African Soldier" in the said trust deed to the war of 1939-1945, shall be deemed to include a reference to the war of 1914-1918, and any reference in that trust deed and in the said constitution to that definition shall be construed accordingly.

2. This Act shall be called the National War Fund Act, 1970. Short title.
