ACT

To amend the Local Government Training Act, 1985, so as to further define "local government body"; to provide that the provincial secretary of every province shall be a member of the Training Board; and to provide that certain moneys may only be utilized to defray expenditure arising from the provision of training approved by the Training Board; and to provide for matters connected therewith.

BE IT ENACTED by the State President and the Parliament of the Republic of South Africa, as follows:—

Amendment of section 1 of Act 41 of 1985

1. Section 1 of the Local Government Training Act, 1985 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act), is hereby amended by the substitution for the definition of "local government body" of the following definition:

"'local government body' means a body, council or institution intended in section 84 (1) (f) of the Provincial Government Act, 1961 (Act No. 32 of 1961), and includes—

- 10 (a) a Coloured and Indian consultative, local affairs and management committee;
- (b) **[an institution or body established under the Coloured Land Areas Law, 1979 (Law No. 1 of 1979), of the Coloured Persons Representative Council of the Republic of South Africa]** a board of management or
- 15 board referred to in section 1 of the Rural Areas Act (House of Representatives), 1987 (Act No. 9 of 1987);
- (c) **[a community council established under the Community Councils Act, 1977 (Act No. 125 of 1977)]** any local government body established by
- 20 virtue of the provisions of section 30 (2) (a) of the Black Administration Act, 1927 (Act No. 38 of 1927);
- (d) a local authority as defined in the Black Local Authorities Act, 1982 (Act No. 102 of 1982);
- (e) a regional services council established under section 3 of the Regional Services Councils Act, 1985 (Act No. 109 of 1985); or
- 25 (f) a body or institution declared under subsection (2) a local government body for the purposes of this Act;"

LOCAL GOVERNMENT TRAINING AMENDMENT ACT, 1988

Act No. 84, 1988

Amendment of section 2 of Act 41 of 1985, as amended by section 30 of Act 32 of 1987

2. Section 2 of the principal Act is hereby amended—

- (a) by the addition to subsection (2) of the following paragraph:
“(i) the provincial secretary of every province of the Republic.”; and
5 (b) by the addition to subsection (3) of the following paragraph:
“(f) the provincial secretaries, the provincial secretary concerned.”.

Amendment of section 8 of Act 41 of 1985

3. Section 8 of the principal Act is hereby amended by the substitution for subsection (3) of the following subsection:

- 10 “(3) Moneys allocated in terms of subsection (1) (a) and (b) may be utilized only to defray the expenditure arising from the provision of training **[in terms of an] approved [training course] by the Training Board.**”.

Short title

4. This Act shall be called the Local Government Training Amendment Act, 1988.
