HOTELS AMENDMENT ACT, 1974

Act No. 91, 1974

\mathbf{ACT}

To amend the provisions of the Hotels Act, 1965, relating to the functions and powers of the Hotel Board; and to the registration of a person as an hotelier; and to provide for incidental matters.

(Afrikaans text signed by the State President.)
(Assented to 11 November 1974.)

BE IT ENACTED by the State President, the Senate and the House of Assembly of the Republic of South Africa, as follows:—

1. Section 4 of the Hotels Act, 1965 (hereinafter referred to as Amendment of the principal Act), is hereby amended by the substitution for section 4 of Act paragraph (d) of the following paragraph:

"(d) to adopt such measures as it may consider necessary or desirable to achieve and maintain a satisfactory standard in the quality of the accommodation, meals and service provided by hotels;".

2. Section 23 of the principal Act is hereby amended by the Amendment of substitution for subsection (3) of the following subsection:

section 23 of section 24 of section 25 of section

"(3) Unless the person for whose registration application Act 70 of 1965. is made is disqualified in terms of the regulations from being registered as an hotelier, the board shall upon receipt of such application forthwith register such person as the hotelier of the hotel in question."

3. This Act shall be called the Hotels Amendment Act, 1974. Short title.
