

BOARD NOTICE 167 OF 2015**NOMINATION OF CANDIDATE TO SERVE AS FULL-TIME MEMBER OF THE NATIONAL ENERGY REGULATOR ("NERSA") PRIMARILY RESPONSIBLE FOR ADMINISTRATION - CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER**

NERSA is a regulatory body established as a juristic person in terms of Section 3 of the National Energy Regulator Act, 40 of 2004 ("the Act"). NERSA's mandate is to regulate the electricity, piped-gas and petroleum pipelines industries in terms of the Electricity Regulation Act 4 of 2006, the Gas Act 48 of 2001 and the Petroleum Pipelines Act 60 of 2003.

In terms of Section 5(1) of the Act, NERSA consists of four full-time and five part-time members appointed by the Minister of Energy. A part-time member of the Regulator holds office for a period of four years while a full-time member holds office for a period of five years.

Nominations are hereby invited for the position of full-time regulator member responsible for administration. The candidate must be a suitably qualified with a minimum of a master's degree or equivalent:

- Minimum of fifteen (15) years working experience with at least five (5) years at Executive Management level.
- Five (5) years' experience in economic regulation or regulatory environment.
- A sound understanding of economic and energy regulatory policies in the South African context especially those pertaining to the South African Electricity, Piped-gas and Petroleum Pipelines industries are of great importance.

Candidates nominated must be strictly South African citizen or holders of a permit as permanent residents in the Republic who are disqualified in terms of Section 6 of the Act.
