SCHEDULE 2

DEFINITIONS

1. In these regulations, "regulations" mean the regulations published as *Regulations pertaining to the conduct, administration and management of the National Senior Certificate examination*, published as *Government Regulation Notice No. R872 in Government Regulation Gazette No. 31337 of 29 August 2008* and amended as: *Government Notices No. 1327 and 1328 in Government Gazette, Vol. 522, No.31680 dated 12 December 2008*; and *Government Notices No. 1041 and 1042 in Government Gazette, Vol.533, No.32678 dated 3 November 2009*.
Regulation Notice No. 188 in Government Gazette No. 35103 dated 2 March 2012.
Regulation Notice No. 444 in Government Gazette No. 35429 dated 7 June 2012.
Regulation Notice No. 371 in Government Gazette No. 37651 dated 16 May 2014.

Amendment of Regulation 9 of the Regulations

1. Regulation 9 is hereby amended by-

(a) the substitution for sub-regulation (2) of the following sub-regulation-
“(1) The Minister of Basic Education may approve a new subject to be offered by a learner as part of the **[7-subject]** 8-subject package, subject to specific conditions, as contemplated in Annexure B of this document and Annexure B1 of the policy document, *National policy pertaining to the programme and promotion requirements of the National Curriculum Statement Grades R – 12.*”

Short Title and Commencement

These Regulations may be cited as the *Regulations Pertaining to the Conduct, Administration and Management of the National Senior Certificate examination* and will come into effect on the date of publication in the *Government Gazette*.
