**BOARD NOTICE 2 OF 2016**

**LEGAL NOTICE: ELECTION OF THE ALLIED HEALTH PROFESSIONS  
COUNCIL OF SOUTH AFRICA – CALL FOR NOMINATIONS FOR APPOINTED  
MEMBERS OF COUNCIL WHO WILL ALSO SERVE ON PROFESSIONAL  
BOARDS**

In terms of the provisions of Subregulation 4(1) (GNR127, 12/02/2001) of the Allied Health Professions Act, 63 of 1982, as amended ('the Act'), notice is hereby given to call for nominations of 5 persons appointed by the Minister of Health to serve on the Allied Health Professions Council of South Africa. In terms of Section 5(1)(b)(ii) and (iii) of the Act the Minister of Health shall appoint to the Council:

- one person who shall be appointed on account of his/her knowledge of the law; and
- four persons as community representatives, who shall be appointed on account of expertise in the fields of health, education and welfare.

Nominations of persons received in terms of Subregulations 4(3) and (4) of the Act shall be in writing, signed by the person making the nomination and shall provide that the nominee declares that he/she is not registered in terms of the Allied Health Professions Act, is a South African citizen residing within the Republic and is not an unrehabilitated insolvent. The nomination form shall be signed by the nominee indicating his/her acceptance of the nomination and willingness to serve on Council should he/she be appointed. All nominations shall include a **detailed** curriculum vitae of the nominee.
