NOTICE IN TERMS OF SECTIONS 14 AND 3(4) OF THE CULTURAL INSTITUTIONS ACT, 1998 (ACT NO.119 OF 1998): ABOLITION OF, AND THE AMALGAMATION OF THE WINDYBROW CENTRE INTO THE MARKET THEATRE FOUNDATION

I, Nkosinathi Emmanuel Mthethwa, Minister of Arts and Culture hereby under Section 14(1) of the Cultural Institutions Act, 1998 ("the Act") withdraw the declaration in terms of Government Gazette No. 27489 (Notice No. 377 published on 22 April 2005) of the Windybrow Centre (née Windybrow Centre for Arts) in Johannesburg, as a Cultural Institution with effect from 01 April 2016.

In terms of section 3(4) of the Act, I hereby declare that with effect from 01 April 2016, the Windybrow Centre shall be almalgated with the Market Theatre Foundation and this declared institution shall remain known as the Market Theatre Foundation.

I hereby direct that the assets, rights, liabilities and obligations of the Windybrow Centre, as they existed immediately before 01 April 2016 shall with effect from 01 April 2016 vest in the Market Theatre Foundation. A reference in any law or document to the Windybrow Centre shall with effect from 01 April 2016 be regarded as a reference to the Market Theatre Foundation. All other ancillary matters as a result of the amalgamation shall be dealt with in terms of the Act.
