



COMMUNICATIONS ACT OF 2005 (ACT NO. 36 OF 2005), AS  
AMENDED.**

The Independent Communications Authority of South Africa ("ICASA") hereby publish the Numbering Plan Amendment Regulations, in terms of sections 68 and 4(7)(b) of the Electronic Communications Act, 2005 (Act 36 of 2005), as amended.

The purpose of the amendment is to enable Machine Related Services migrations to proceed smoothly without disruptions to life critical services.

## **SCHEDULE 1**

### **Definitions**

1. In this notice "the Regulations" means the regulations published by Government Notices No. 39861 of 2016.

### **Amendment of regulation 22 of the Regulations**

2. Regulation 22 of the Regulations is hereby amended by the substitution for sub-regulation (1) of the following sub-regulation:

"(1) All machine related number changes must be migrated to the new number range on or before 28 September 2018."

### **Short Title and Commencement**

These regulations are called the Numbering Plan Amendment Regulations, 2017 and will come into operation by publication in the Government Gazette.
