

SOUTH AFRICAN RESERVE BANK**NOTICE 766 OF 2017****THE BANKS ACT, 1990 (ACT NO. 94 OF 1990 – “THE BANKS ACT”)****CONSENT GRANTED IN TERMS OF SECTION 34 OF THE BANKS ACT FOR A FOREIGN INSTITUTION TO ESTABLISH A REPRESENTATIVE OFFICE WITHIN THE REPUBLIC OF SOUTH AFRICA: BANQUE LOMBARD ODIER & CIE SA**

Notice is hereby given for general information, in accordance with the provisions of section 30 of the Banks Act that Banque Lombard Odier & Cie SA, an institution that lawfully conducts business similar to the business of a bank in Switzerland, has been granted permission by the Registrar of Banks, in terms of section 34 of the Banks Act, to establish a representative office within the Republic of South Africa, with effect from 19 June 2017. The representative office referred to above is, however, not authorised to conduct the business of a bank in the Republic of South Africa.
