NOTICE OF TERMINATION OF AN INVESTIGATION INTO THE ALLEGED DUMPING OF DETONATING FUSES AND DELAY DETONATORS (COMMONLY KNOWN AS SHOCK TUBES), ORIGINATING IN OR IMPORTED FROM THE PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF CHINA (CHINA)

The International Trade Administration Commission (the Commission) gave public notice of its investigation into the alleged dumping of detonating fuses and delay detonators (commonly known as shock tubes), originating in or imported from China in *Government Gazette* No. 32348 dated 3 July 20019 (Notice No. 916 of 2009).

Due to the fact that no progress has been made with regard to the above mentioned investigation and the long period since the initiation of this matter, the Commission decided to terminate the investigation. The Applicant was advised and no objection was received.
