Definitions

For the purposes of this Directive:-

"Active Employer" means an employer that is carrying on business in the Republic and is registered with the Compensation Fund as required by section 80(1) of Compensation for Occupational and Diseases Act 130 of 1993 and has complied with the provisions of section 82 of the Act with regards to the submission of Return of Earning (ROE).

"Inactive Employer" means an employer that has notified the Compensation Fund that it has:

- a) Ceased to carry on business or that there are no employees employed by the business; or
- b) Failed to submit ROEs for the past four (4) consecutive years of Assessment excluding the current year of Assessment.
